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Child Care Subsidy Transition

It's been a pretty smooth transition from the old Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR) to the now combined **Child Care Subsidy (CCS)**. I'm happy to say that most of our families have now transitioned over.

Under the new law we were also required to have a "Complying Written Agreement" signed by all our existing families. Thanks to all of those that have signed and returned these agreements.

Parents are also advised that: under the new subsidy the government withholds 5% of your subsidy each week on the fee payable to us. This means your out of pocket cost will be a little higher than expected. All payments will be reconciled at the end of the financial year when your tax gets done.
