Kindyhub Parent App



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If you haven't yet, be sure to download our parent app to easily keep up to date with all the latest news and events. The link for the app was emailed to all new families, please speak to management if you did not receive it.

Once you have downloaded the app you (and your chosen relatives) will have a secure private login to access information about what your child has done throughout the day. You also have the option to disable email alerts if you wish, and simply access your child's information through the app, at a convenient time for you. Each day that your child attends, you will receive a group daily report from their care area, informing you of some of learning, activities and events that have occurred, together with a selection of photos.

Information such as your child's food and fluid intake, nappy changes and sleep times are updated throughout the day and an instant message option is available for easily communicating with your child's educators to share information.

Children's E-portfolios containing photos, learning information and medical are stored in an individual profile similar to Facebook, but is only accessible by the child's families and service staff.



Immunisation Register

As of February 2019, it is a requirement for families to provide current immunisation history statements for their children. We are requesting that all parents access any one of the below means and send us a copy of the child's immunisation certificate.

A child's current AIR (Australia Immunisation Record) – Immunisation history statement can be accessed at any time by the parent / guardian through:

- MyGov, by logging into your Medicare online account
- Medicare express Plus App, by logging into the Medicare account
- Visiting a Medicare or Centrelink office, or
- Calling the AIR General Enquiries Line on 1800 653 809 for the statement to be posted.

We can no longer accept the copy from a child's "purple book".

We will be updating all of our children's records and request that ALL parents send, or bring in an **updated/current immunisation history statement** for each child or children enrolled for the 2019 year **by FRIDAY 8 February 2019**
