Subicare ELC uses the Kindyhub app to communicate with families. Kindyhub is secure web-based software enabling educators to simplify and streamline documentation and enhance communication with families, in-turn improving children's learning outcomes.

The Kindyhub app is an easy to use digital communication tool for parents with children in care. Enables educators to share information securely with parents about news, current events and progress on their child's achievements.

Within your enrolment pack you would have received a Kindyhub information sheet and a permission form to complete and return.

Once you have downloaded the app you (and your chosen relatives) will have a secure private login to access information about what your child has done throughout the day. You also have the option to disable email alerts if you wish, and simply access your child's information through the app, at a convenient time for you. Each day that your child attends, you will receive a group daily report from their care area, informing you of some of learning, activities and events that have occurred, together with a selection of photos.

Information such as your child's food and fluid intake, nappy changes and sleep times are updated throughout the day and an instant message option is available for easily communicating with your child's educators to share information.

Children's E-portfolios containing photos, learning information and medical are stored in an individual profile similar to Facebook, but is only accessible by the child's families and service staff.

Our face-to-face communication is undoubtedly one the most important aspects of maintaining great relationships between staff and families and Kindyhub is a fantastic compliment to those daily interactions. Family input and feedback towards service operations and children's learning is always welcome and encouraged and through use of the Kindyhub app, it is now even easier to do.
