Kindyhub is a fast and convenient way for educators and families to interact and share information. We'd like to take a moment to familiarise you with a few of the information sharing options available to you via Kindyhub.

**Communicate** - This is a quick and easy way for families and staff to share information such as daily handovers or absent days or important service messages for all families.

**Reporting** - This is how educators share information relating to your child's learning and development and daily routines with you on a regular basis. This includes learning stories, daily reports, daily charts Eg. Food & fluid intake

**Eportfolios and Photos** - Information and photos about your child is stored on their E-portfolio and can be accessed at any time, allowing you to view them at a time that is convenient to you.

Family Stories - We encourage you to share information about your child's current interests and home life, outings and special events. This information helps contribute to planning and helps establish a sense of belonging for your child.





## Education Update...

In each care area at Subicare you will find an educational program board, showcasing key components of our educational program cycle.

Photos: The photos displayed are of the children who are currently on the program. The planning undertaken to create the program is based off spontaneous observations of these children and the activities selected for that fortnight have been carefully chosen to extend on learning and development.

Key Educator Groups: The children in each are divided in to groups and allocated a key educator.

Key educators observe, monitor, guide and document the progress for their group of key educator children throughout the year. They can also act as a 'go to' person for families when discussing children's learning and development. Each child is observed numerous times throughout the year, both individually and part of a group.

Educational Program: A paper copy of the current educational program for that care area is always on display. New programs are posted fortnightly and if you have any questions or queries regarding the program, speak with the senior educator for that area or services the educational leader.
