clean surfaces and object such as doorknobs, benches, table tops, keyboards and phones regularly



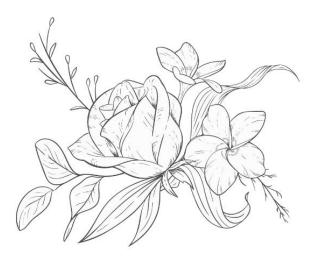
