


Our administration area will be getting a long awaited makeover this Wednesday the 7th of July.

Subicare is a community based, not for profit incorporated association, run by a parent/community member volunteer board that works closely with centre management in overseeing the services day to day operations.

The Subicare board is responsible for reviewing and setting the strategic plans, budgets, and governance of Subicare, and ensuring the centre operates in line with its purpose, philosophy, and values. Parent-based management enables families to be involved in an advisory and consultative capacity, while collaboratively creating strategic and operational objectives for the service.

Subicare's success is greatly dependant on the involvement of families and wider community members.

The board meets once a month with the Director and a staff representative. A maximum of 10 board members are nominated and elected each year at the Annual General Meeting (AGM), with positions opening for new board members to join each year. The AGM for this year is tentatively planned for early November.
