# COVID-19 UPDATE

This week all families were sent a message via kindyhub about an important update from our Board Chair, Emma Thunder. Attached to this message were 2 documents: Subicare's COVID-19 Management Plan - Scenarios for Families Policy and a letter highlighting the policy and its key points. If you have not done so already, please read these documents in preparation for any potential circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Key points highlighted within the policy include:

- Signs, symptoms and criteria for COVID isolation or testing protocols
  - Keeping informed in the event of a service closure
  - Fees and charges in the event of a service closure
  - Information and protocols for close contacts,

If you are unsure about what you are required to do in any circumstance or if you have any concerns about the policies outlined in the policy document, please don't hesitate to raise them with management or the Chair, so that we can explore options to address them. The Subicare Board will continue to monitor and review the situation as it evolves and will keep you updated with any changes that might affect you.
