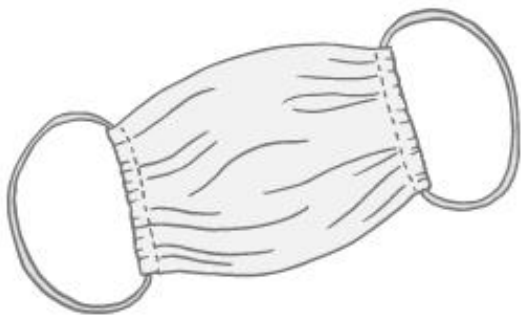
Please join us in celebrating Book Week 2022

While masks are not currently mandatory, we do ask that you please consider wearing one during drop off & pick up times anyway.



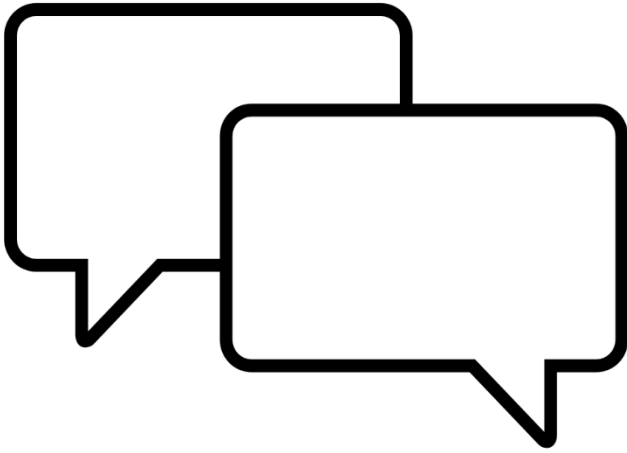
We are trying our very best to try and reduce illness for our children, families and staff and keep our community safe.
